


An unusual reception area on the river

With a length of 37 metres and a beam of 6.5 metres wide, the boat Le Sax can accommodate receptions for up to 250 people. In its catering version, it can seat 150 people at an indoor table, spread over two levels.

It can be sailed all year round, mainly on the Meuse between Givet and Liège, but also on all the Belgium's main waterways. Equipped with powerful exterior spotlights, the boat can take you on a cruise by day or night.

The boat is accessible to people with mobility thanks to its vast one level main deck.

A boat with lots of possibilities

The boat is laid out on two levels. The main deck is entirely on one level, making it accessible to people with reduced mobility. This 110m² area is particularly popular for hosting meals and dancing parties.

The 70m² upper deck is the ideal place to enjoy an aperitif and a bite to eat. Offering access to three terraces, it's a multi-modal space of relaxation and lively discussions.

The Sax is usually rented with its furniture, crockery and glassware. However, it can also be refurbished to suit the specific requirements of your event.
